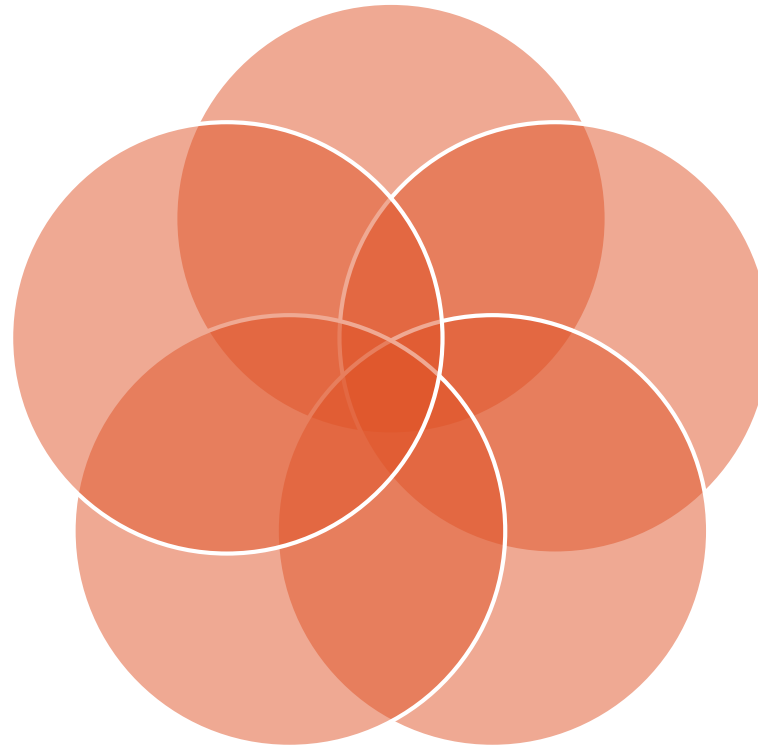

- Opportunities to enhance and extend the experience of being a Nether Stowe student

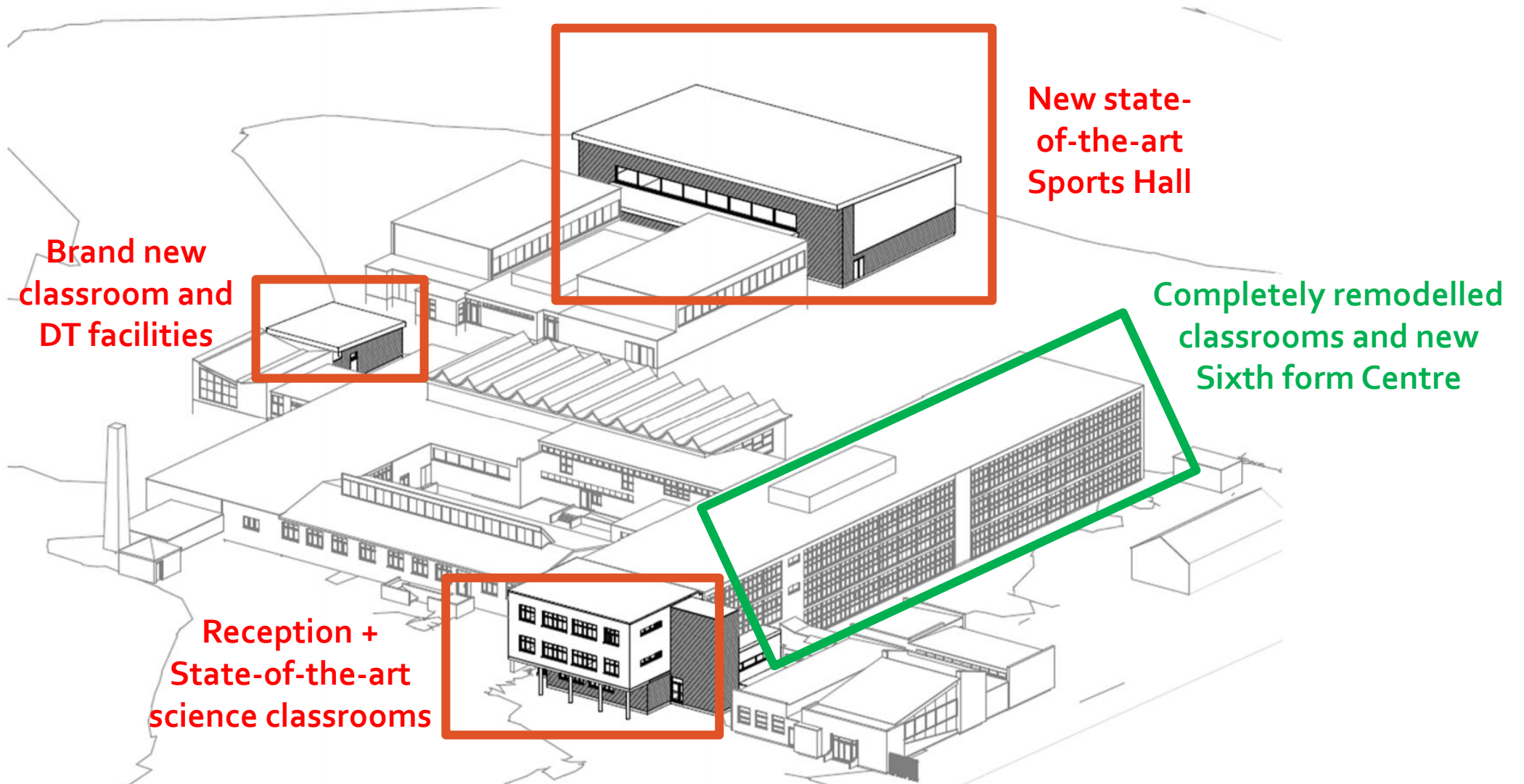
Developing our Sixth Form
